Shetty Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Shetty Education Hub, Shahabad Road, Kalburagi-585105, Karnataka has submitted an application for permission for sanction of 60 seats in BHMS course for the academic year 23-24. The College has submitted the Part 1 information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. The college has been inspected by the inspectors dated 08.08.2023 and 09.08.2023. MARB has examined the inspection report and profile of the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Standard Requirements as per the prevailing regulations under NCH Act 2020, as per section 29 and subsection (3) of the Act.

As per the observations made by MARB, following information are provided for immediate rectification of the shortfalls. College shall fulfil all functional requirements as per the Minimum Standard Requirements as mentioned below:-

- 1. Teaching faculty:-**Total 27 fulltime faculty for UG are submitted. The college shall appoint faculties for all departments.
- 2. Hospital details:-**
 - Case registers and diet registers are not submitted.
 - IPD case sheet not matched with the doctor duty roster as well as with nurse duty roster.
 - Case taking performa are not complete in aspect of Homoeopathy case taking.
 - Case records shall be submitted as per the direction issued from MARB. IPD and OPD case records (copy of one OP and one IP cases of 1st and last day of every month) shall be submitted for verification.
 - Case records should be maintained with demographic details of the patient such as name, age sex, address, phone number etc. and all follow up attendance should be recorded on the case records.
 - Case sheets shall be maintained with complete case analysis and evaluation and repertorisation and made available in medical record room for academic purpose of students.
 - Lab investigation report should be maintained properly in case records.

3. **Financial details:-**

- Copy of Form-16 of the faculties from traces portal shall be submitted for verification.
- Teaching Attendance and Acquaintance are not matched.

4. **Miscellaneous Details:-**

- Biometric attendance shall be provided of all staff with arrival and departure time.
- Website should be updated.


All the shortfalls observed in your College shall be rectified within a period of 30 days or before counselling initiates, whichever earlier and compliance report shall be submitted to the MARB, failing which the conditional permission issued will be cancelled without further notice.

Considering the above observations, and facilities available, MARB has decided to issue **Conditional permission to Shetty Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Shetty Education Hub, Shahabad Road, Kalburagi-585105, Karnataka for conducting BHMS course for the academic year 2023- 24 with intake capacity of 60 seats.**

All admissions shall be made from NEET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India Quota. Counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective Counseling Authority of State/ UT govt as designated by Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85 % seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the central govt for All India quota or the student admitted thereunder.

The category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by Medical Assessment and Rating Board.
